Fire Inspection

The fire inspection takes place before noon on Saturday, November 18th. The inspector may ask to see your fire extinguisher to check the date and gauge or to see proof of fire retardant. Also your electrical cord configuration is very important. Please be in your booth, and cooperative.

Stock Must Be Removed

Remember that all stock must be removed from your booth by 8 pm on Sunday night. If you are selling next weekend, your booth structure and furniture may stay.

Office/Market Schedule

The office will be open only on Wednesday next week from 10 am-4 pm. The building will be open for set up from 12 pm-7 pm on Wednesday. The building will not be open at all on Thanksgiving Day, but there will be security, so you can set up and leave your stock. The building will be open for vendors at 7 am next Friday.

I Spy Elves - Customers will Ask!

Because customers will ask you about elves, here are details that will help you answer questions: Our special promotion for Opening Weekend is a game called "I Spy Elves." At least 30 Market members have elves tucked into their displays. Customers can pick up a "Elf spotter" sheet at the Info Booth and look through the Market for the elves. They write the booth number where they see the elves on the card, then turn it in at She's Beads (booth #30), Twisted Goddess/Terrapin Toys (#120) or with !Spring at Yodamoon (#239 in Holiday Hall).

The first 250 who find at least 6 elves will be rewarded with a wooden elf ornament. Those who find at least 6 elves will be entered into a drawing to win one of the elves - many but not all are up for adoption. Those who find at least 20 elves will have a chance to win a \$100 gift certificate.

Market members are not eligible to win ornaments, elves or the gift certificate.

Here Only This Weekend?

Remember to let your customers know if this is your only weekend selling, or if you are not coming back until the last three days. Many folks assume that everyone is here all the time and will come looking for you later, so capture those sales today!

Credit Card Transactions

We are pleased to provide the service of credit card transactions to facilitate your sales. We take Visa, Mastercard, American Express and Discover. There are full instruction and visa slips for your use in the Vendor Service Center. Complete the form with your full first and last name, NOT your business name or your boothsitter's name. In order to assist your customer in getting back to your booth, we have color coded the slips to match your area of the room.

Keep your slips each day to confirm that your check is correct. The checks for this weekend will be available in the Vendor Service Center on Friday, November 24th.

If you are not selling on Thanksgiving weekend, we will mail your checks to the address we have on file for you.

Postcards, Posters, Gift Guides

Holiday Market postcards, Holiday Market posters and Gift Guides are all available in the Vendor Service Center. Feel free to grab some and help spread the word. Put a poster up at your gym in the break room at work or your local coffee shop, leave a couple of guidebooks at your Doctor's office. Any place where you see lots of people is a great spot for a Holiday Market announcement.

Remove Tape, Please!

If you are in the same space for the entire show, help us out and pull your tape off the floor once you are sure you are in the right location. At the end of the Holiday Market, we are required to pull all the tape off of the floor and tape that has been in place for six weeks can be kind of hard to remove. Thanks for your help!

Important Parking Info

Park your vehicle in the parking lot behind the building. The front parking lot is for customers. Don't leave anything in your car, as thefts do happen.

Holiday Market Tips

Electricity and the extension cord

Each booth has 500 watts of electric power. Only three pronged (grounded) extension cords are allowed to be used in the Holiday Market. As simple as this may seem, every year the fire marshal finds a few vendors that are still using the smaller 'zip cord' ungrounded type of cord. These are not permitted. Power strips are acceptable. Please make the investment in grounded cords and watch the wattage on light bulbs. Check Your Fire Extinguisher

Add this to your HM preparation list: make sure your fire extinguisher has a current tag. If not, now's a good time to get it updated before the fire inspection on Opening Day of Holiday Market. If you can't find your fire extinguisher, it's time to get a new one! The minimum size must be a U.L. classification 2A10BC.

Fees & Late Fees

This is a reminder! You must pay all your Park Blocks owings by the end of the season in order to get the points you've earned for those unpaid Market days. These points will be very valuable next year for both Saturday and Holiday Market space allocations. Also, a \$5 late fee is added to your owing after 30 days, and after 60 days a \$10 fee is added.

Avoid the fees and get caught up on all of your Park Blocks past owings!
