## Office/Market Schedule

Next week, the office will be open Wednesday through Friday, from 10 am - 4 pm. The building will be open for set up from 2 pm to 9 pm on Friday, and starting at 7 am on Saturday.

## Gift Certificates, Holiday Dollars

During the weekend, you may have customers present you with Saturday Market gift certificates, Unique Eugene gift certificates or coupons that say "One Holiday Market Dollar." Please accept them the same as cash from your customer, and give change if needed. You may then redeem the certificates at the Vendor Info Center for the equivalent amount in cash.

## Door Prize Drawings

The door prize drawings are back! You can donate a door prize if you like, it will be displayed at the Info Booth until someone wins it. The door prize entry box is at the central Info Booth.

## Stock Must Be Removed

Remember that all stock must be removed from your booth by 9 pm on Sunday night. If you are selling next weekend, your booth structure may stay.

## Helpful Hint for New Folks

Remember to let your customers know if this is your only weekend selling, or if you are not coming back until the last three days. Many folks assume that everyone is here all the time and will come looking for you later, so capture those sales today! If you are coming back later, you may want to give them one of the HM flyers (in the Vendor Center) with your selling dates and space circled on the map.

## In case of Flu or Other Emergency

If you are ill, please have someone sell for you. Just let the office know who will be filling in. Requirements for employee selling days are waived in this case.

In case of illness or weather emergency that keeps you from opening your booth, please let the office know so we can cover and sign your booth for the day, or until you arrive.

Reminder from Mom: Eat right, get plenty of rest, drink lots of water, cough or sneeze into your sleeve and wash your hands or use hand sanitizer frequently.

## Kareng Fund Fundraisers

The Kareng fund was created in 2002 to honor two very generous members, Karen Buxton and Karen

"Liza" Loube. It serves as a relief fund for members of the Saturday Market that have experienced a traumatic event that threatens their livelihood. During the Holiday Market, we will have two Kareng Fund fundraisers—The 7th Annual "Kareng Fund Auction With Percussive Interludes" and the "Ten for 10 Thousand" raffle.

The Auction will be held on December 22, 9:00 a.m. - 10:00 a.m. and is a way for members to contribute to the Fund while having fun and getting great deals.

The raffle is a way for the general public to get donate to the fund—it has a catchy slogan "Ten for 10 Thousand". The Ten for 10 Thousand raffle is an effort of the membership to sell a thousand raffle tickets at \$10 each for a single prize consisting of a basket holding donations of members' works. To donate to the raffle basket, place an item with your card in the basket on the table in the office during Holiday Market. Donations accepted until the drawing at 3:59 p.m. on December 24.

More information about raffle tickets will be available in the next couple of weeks, so stay tuned!

## Credit Card Sales

Please follow our tried and true credit card sales process. Use the slips we have provided for this purpose which are available in the vendor service center. Complete the form with your full first and last name, NOT your business name or your boothsitter's name. Guide the customer to the information booth by pointing out the colorful flags. After they return, check their slip. Does it have your name written on the bottom? Check the date and the amount to make sure they are correct and then record the authori-



zation number in your records and give the customer the item, they keep the slip. If the sale was done before 2:30 pm on Sunday the check will be available from 6 pm to 6:30 outside the vendor office. Otherwise, pick it up in the vendor office the following weekend or call us to mail it to you. There is a 5% charge for using the market's credit card service. You may not charge the customer extra. However, you may discount for cash or make a choice not to use the service.
