

Good Morning Saturday Marketers!

Should be a mild day today and hopefully it will bring out the shoppers!

I wanted to remind you that the Holiday Market work task sheets are located at the information booth every Saturday. Please sign up for a task. Your volunteer time helps the market hold down costs. If you successfully complete your task you will receive a refund of \$25 of your Holiday Market fees. If you are 65 or older, you are exempt from the required work task. Please contact Vanessa Roy if you have been assessed the \$25 fee and meet the 65+ exemption. She will make sure the \$25 is removed from your account.

If you need financial assistance to purchase materials to create your inventory for Holiday Market, The Neighborhood Economic Development Corporation (NEDCO) offers a 3-month, low interest loan. This is a great way to get the materials you need to make your product at a very low cost. If you would like more information on this program please contact NEDCO at 541-345-7106.

The Saturday Market will hold its Annual "Market Sale Day" on October 14<sup>th</sup>. This is when members sell their overstock to make way for their Holiday Market items. 

## Holiday Market Update!

**BOOKING HOLIDAY MARKET SPACES:** Vanessa is deep into the booking process. She's currently contacting members with more than 8 Holiday Market points. Booking will continue into October.

**IF YOU HAVEN'T TURNED IN YOUR APP:** If you have not turned in your application, you can still do so! You can still apply online at our website!

**STATEMENT QUESTIONS:** Review your Holiday Market statement for accuracy. Verify your key words, your Holiday Market dates, your space, and your balance. If you have any questions about your Holiday Market statement, or need assistance in understanding the statement, please call Vanessa in the office.

**MEMBERS WITH 0 POINTS:** Even if you have just started at Market, you can sell at Holiday Market. You will be able to get a space on the first weekend, and possibly other weekends! **Vanessa is continuing with the booking process through the end of September.**

**DEPOSIT:** We require that you secure your space with an initial payment of \$225 for a Main Hall space, \$125 for a Holiday Hall, or \$100 if you have less than 15 Holiday Market points.

**WE ARE NOW DEPOSITING ALL HOLIDAY MARKET DEPOSIT CHECKS AND RUNNING CARDS RIGHT AWAY.**

## The Elves of Holiday Market

The Opening Weekend of Holiday Market, Nov. 18-19, is full of elves! We are looking for a lot of artisans to participate this year!

**If you'd like to play along, here's what you need to do:**

**1.** Create an elf! It can be three dimensional, or two dimensional. Last year there were doll elves, felted elves, an elf glazed on a bowl, wooden elves, tiny elves, big elves, and a Marketeer elf.

**2.** Get your elf into a photo shoot. This will let us include your elves in the game sheet that attendees use to find the elves. Get your elf or a photo of your elf to Jake in the office, or bring it to Market for a photo, by Saturday, Oct. 28. We will be asking if you want to gift your elf as a prize, or not.

**3.** During opening weekend (Nov. 18-19), display the elf in your booth. If you want to make an elf but won't be selling on opening weekend, we can find someone to adopt your elf for the weekend.

While you are waiting your turn to pick a space in the morning, DO NOT stand in the street. Other marketeers need to drive in to S. Park to unload their gear, even while the morning call is occurring. Reduce the risk of accidents by staying on the sidewalks.

## Does a Product Meet Standards?

If you see a member selling a product at Market and you're not sure if it meets our Standards, you may acquire a Notice of Concern form at the Info Booth, fill it out, and turn it in to the booth or our office. This is an important part of ensuring that the "Maker is the Seller" standard is upheld by all members of The Saturday Market.

A Notice of Concern prompts an investigation by the General Manager and is reported at the next Standards Meeting. If further action is required, a Notice to Appear before the Standards Committee may be sent to the member whose products are in question. We ask that vendors refrain from member-to-member confrontations, they are not part of our Standards process and do not serve our Market community's goals. For Standards questions, please contact a member of the Standards Committee or the General Manager.

Also available at the Info Booth is a Behavioral Incident Report Form, if you need to let management know about non-Standards related issues. *Stay positive and we can all have a great experience at The Saturday Market!*


