## Change in Holiday Market Points for Next Year

There is a change in the way Holiday Market points will be figured for next year. You will not be able to earn any Holiday Market points for next year in April and May of next year. All your Holiday Market points for 2011 must be earned by Dec. 24, 2010. On the up side, you will need fewer points to keep your HM reserved space. This year you needed 35, next year you will only need 31.

If you are concerned about your HM points, we have a handy worksheet available at the Info Booth that will help you figure it out, or call the office during the week and we can help you out.

You may have someone want to pay for their purchase with purple and green \$10 Unique Eugene Gift Certificates. The Market is a member of Unique Eugene, so please go ahead and take them just like cash. You can then use them to pay your fees, or just cash them at the Info Booth.

Most of these gift certificates are sold at several local schools (like Waldorf and South Eugene) as scrip. Unique Eugene sells them to the schools at 90% of face value, in effect donating 10% to the schools.
